About the Program

For over 20 years, Summer Fellowship (SF) has been a community-focused program sponsored by the Kings Church of Christ. Our program is open to all children ages 5-12, regardless of belief or church affiliation. Although it is not our intention to convert or offend anyone, our program includes bible-based, Christian teachings. All classes are kid friendly and age appropriate.

We do not baptize any child in our program. If a child desires an extended knowledge of the church, we invite the entire family to join us in a bible study or worship service.

By registering your child in this program, you agree to allow your child to participate in all aspects of the program, including GROWING IN GOD and PRAISE AND WORSHIP.

What to Expect

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TIME

Kids may arrive NO EARLIER than 8:30 a.m. and must be picked up NO LATER than 6:00 p.m. If you cannot provide transportation for your child to arrive and depart at the required times, please do not register for this program. We have already added extended hours to accommodate parents and cannot allow children in the building before 8:30 am or to stay past 6 pm. Any child picked up past 6 pm more than 3 times will be dismissed from the program.

Kids 10 years and older may arrive and depart on their own, only if they have written permission from a parent/ guardian

VOLUNTEERS Our volunteers are trustworthy, well-trained, energetic individuals affiliated with the Kings Church of Christ. There will always be at least 2 coordinators on site. Our adult/ child ratio is 2-12 and team leaders ages 15- 17 are always supervised by an adult team leader or coordinator.

MEALS Daily breakfast, lunch and snacks are provided. Those with special dietary needs should arrive with breakfast/ lunch daily. **On Trip Days**, parents are to provide their child with a sack lunch.

ATTIRE Kids are required to wear our SF t-shirt everyday and should wear comfortable clothes and sneakers. One free shirt is given to each child during registration. Additional shirts are \$7-10 each. Parents of younger children may be asked to bring in an extra set of clothes for accidents. **On Trip Days**, all kids must wear program t-shirts to attend trips.



TUTOR HOUR Each student is required to bring their "summer packet" given to them by their school. Packets will be kept on-site throughout the program so students can work on them daily. Many of our SF team leaders are educators and college students and will be providing academic help to students each day. If your child does bring a school packet, he/she will be assigned a grade level packet to complete during this session

RULES Please review these rules with your child before the program begins. Children that consistently break rules will be dismissed from the program. Refunds are not given for behavioral dismissals.

Daily Activities & Field Trips

GROWING IN GOD: VISIONS, MISSIONS AND VALUES
We will explore the bible to understand God's VISION for all, learn to value what God VALUES and set upon an exciting MISSION for God's glory.

PIANO LESSONS W/ DY
We are excited to be offering piano lessons to kids ages 9-12. Each week, students will receive (2) thirty minute classes guided by Dy Wilson. Students will be taught the Hoffman Academy Method, a fun and engaging program that teaches kids with no prior experience how to play. All materials and equipment will be provided by the program. For parents that desire to extend their child's ability, additional class information will be given.

HIP-HOP WITH DREW
Drew is a professional hip hop instructor that will teach kids the basics of hip hop dance as well as a few cool moves to show off in front of family and friends!

LEGOS STEM CLASS
Kids will be engaged in this basic physics building class with a combination of themes and free play. Each be challenged to use their imagination to explore and build.

PRAISE & WORSHIP
We will teach the kids how to worship God by learning new songs with added hand motions!

ADDITIONAL CLASSES
Creative cooking, Science lab, Art, Story Time, Fitness and Drama

SIGN LANGUAGE As we teach kids social awareness, we want to give them tools to help them as they encounter many different people in their lives. Each day, kids will learn and practice simple ASL hand techniques, like how to introduce themselves and basic communication.
